INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

The candidate shall extinguish aircraft fuel spill fires using predetermined extinguishing agents in the allotted time.

1. Given an aircraft fuel spill fire and a 100-lb dry chemical fire extinguisher, extinguish the fire so that the agent is applied using proper technique and the fire is extinguished within 25 seconds.	25	
2. Given an aircraft fuel spill fire an ARFF vehicle and a hand line flowing the appropriate gallonage of AFFF for the size spill, extinguish the fuel fire so that the agent is applied using proper technique and the fire is extinguished within 90 seconds.	25	
3. Given an aircraft fuel spill fire an ARFF vehicle turret, and a fire sized to the AFFF flow required for the size of fire, extinguish the fuel fire so that the agent is applied using proper technique and the fire is extinguished within 90 seconds.	25	
4. Given a three-dimensional aircraft fuel fire, an ARFF vehicle hand line(s) using primary and secondary agents, so that dual agent attack is used, the agent is applied using the proper technique, the fire is extinguished, and the fuel source is secured.	25

2. The candidate shall disentangle and extricate a trapped victim.
3. The candidate shall implement initial triage of the victims of the above scenario.
4. The candidate shall preserve the aircraft scene.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

While operating as a member of a team, the candidate in appropriate PrPPE shall gain access to the simulated aircraft accident extricate, triage, overhaul and protect the scene for investigators.
